Inter Out means students who left a school for a school outside the district.

Dist Both means students who both entered the district and left the district. (New column 2001-2002)

Sch Both means students who both entered a school and left a school. (Formerly Both)

Either is an unduplicated count of students who either entered or left or both.

Oct Count is the October 1 headcount from the P-223 report.

Mobility is Either divided by Oct Count.

\*October Count is from the October P-223 officially revised January 2003.

\*\*Thompson is included for the first time in the 2001-2002 mobility report.
