

# Swine Flu Vaccinations

## Saturday, Dec. 5, 2009

*Come to a **free vaccination clinic** to get the best protection against H1N1 influenza (swine flu)!*

Right now, H1N1 vaccine supply is limited. To protect people most at risk, vaccine is only available for:

- Pregnant women
- People who live with or care for babies younger than 6 months
- Young people between the ages of 6 months and 24 years old
- People between 25 through 64 years of age with chronic health problems (such as asthma, diabetes, and heart disease) or weakened immune systems

This free clinic is **for people who can't afford to pay** for H1N1 vaccination (\$12-\$22). You will not be asked for proof of health insurance or citizenship.
