- 1. Kids' Chance of Washington Scholarship** Kids' Chance of Washington is a need based scholarship program for the dependent children of workers killed or seriously disabled in a workplace accident in Washington State. Scholarships may be used for tuition, books, fees, room and general living expenses. Scholarships range from \$500 to \$5000 and recipients can attend any accredited university, community, technical, or vocational college.
