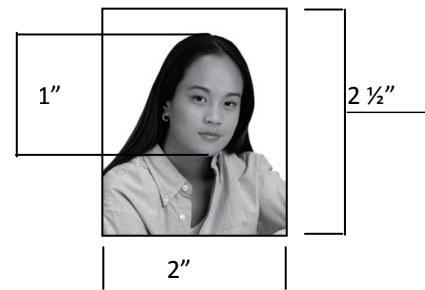
You will need to have your senior yearbook photo taken during the summer by a professional photographer. These photos will be due on **Friday, September 25, 2009**. If you choose not to have a professional picture taken, then be sure to have a photo taken on Highlander Day in August so we have a photo of every senior to use in the yearbook.

While most major photography studios in the area already have these specifications, please have your photographer make a print that matches the following:

SENIOR PORTRAIT SPECIFICATIONS

- ✓ Color picture only. No black and white
- ✓ The background color must be mid to dark tone blue (no exceptions will be allowed)
- ✓ Head size is top of head to chin is (1) one inch
- ✓ Print size is 2 inch width x 2 ½ inch height
- ✓ Head and shoulders only – photos of body shots will be cropped by yearbook staff
- ✓ No full body shots
- ✓ No props, no t-shirts, sweatshirts, no writing on clothing, no hands, no hats

Yearbook staff reserves the right to refuse an inappropriate photo



Student school photos will be used if the professional photo does not meet our standards as listed above.

Don't forget to ask your parents to purchase a baby ad, buddy ad, or senior ad for you. This will give your parents the opportunity to show off all those embarrassing baby pictures and express how proud they are of your many accomplishments. There will be limited space and the ads go quickly, so the deadline for senior ads will be Friday, December 11, 2009. Ad prices for the 2010 yearbook will be:

1/8 page	\$60
1/4 page	\$100
1/2 page	\$175
Full page	\$300

One thing every senior needs is a yearbook from your high school days, especially your senior year. Yearbooks will be on sale in the fall for \$60.
