WHAT IS THE TALLEY VIRTUAL PROGRAM?

- Fully remote program for middle and high school students utilizing Edgenuity courses and certificated
 Edgenuity teachers
- A Talley Virtual Program Mentor monitors progress and checks in with students weekly via zoom
- Edgenuity courses meet all District and State Learning Standards
- Students are no longer "attached" to their comprehensive secondary school...they are enrolled at Talley
- Return to In-Person Learning at your neighborhood school is an option at the beginning of any Trimester



WHAT IS THE TALLEY VIRTUAL PROGRAM? (Cont.)

- Students access course work any time of day from home
- Students utilize RSD issued Chromebook or their personal equipment
- Parents and Students have convenient access to real-time reporting on academic progress
- Edgenuity Teachers and Talley Virtual Mentors are available to support student learning
- Many IEP and 504 accommodations are inherent in Virtual Learning Program



STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

- Commit to independent learning....complete all assignments on an online platform
- Commit to a minimum of 30 hours per week of online learning
- Complete all assignments on an online learning platform
- Participate in weekly virtual face-to-face meetings with school staff
- Middle School Students participate in 30 minute grade level homeroom/advisory weekly and 30 minute small group sessions



FAMILY EXPECTATIONS

- Maintain regular contact with my student's teaching staff
- Help to create a learning environment conducive to online learning
- Commit to ensuring my student will engage in virtual face-to-face meetings with staff
- Support student in selecting courses to fulfill graduation requirements in order to earn a high school diploma

VIRTUAL MIDDLE SCHOOL FEATURES

- Enhanced Family access to progress data: grades, percentage of completion, and log in time
- Students will take five Core and Elective classes
- Advanced math placement if qualified and 8th grade foreign language options
- Grade level homeroom/advisory and small group support meetings will meet weekly
- Teacher mentors will check in with students at least twice a week
- Students may take specialized classes such as fine arts or CTE at home school but must provide own transportation
- Students have access to sports/activities at their home school



VIRTUAL HIGH SCHOOL FEATURES

- Access to Talley counseling and career center services
- Students may participate in sports/activities at their neighborhood high school
- Advanced Placement (AP), Foreign Language and a broad suite of course offerings are available
- Many students "pair" the Virtual Program with Running Start college courses
- Talley has been supporting Virtual students for 9 years and many Talley graduates have completed all 4 years in the Virtual environment.
