New Certificate Renewal Requirements



Additional requirements for certificate renewals are coming.

- Beginning July 1, 2023, teacher and administrator certificate renewal applications must include evidence of professional learning focused on **equity-based school practices**.
- This brief slide deck provides an overview of changes effective July 1, 2023.
- Existing certification requirements remain in place. Check with OSPI for specific requirements based on your certification and endorsements.

If you renew your certificate prior to July 1, 2023 you are not subject to the new requirements that start on July 1, 2023. RENEW NOW!



Equity-Based School Practices

As part of the 100 clock hours for certificate renewal, educators and administrators must demonstrate completion of professional learning focused on equity-based school practices aligned with the cultural competency, diversity, equity, and inclusion (CCDEI) standards under RCW 28A.410.260

Renewal Tips

Renew early! Applications for certificate renewal may be submitted if your current certification expiration date is June 30, 2028 or earlier.

Educators do not lose time if they renew early. If your certificate expires 6/30/2025 and you renew in 2023, you renewed certificate will expire 6/30/2030 just like it would have if you applied closer to the expiration date.

Certificate renewals can take place at any point in the 5-year window as long as the clock hours were earned within the applicable timeframe.

The Professional Certification office is busiest during the summer months.

Applying early for a quicker response time.

Renew your certificate prior to July 1st and you are not subject to the new renewal requirements!
